





VUMBURA ↔ OKAVANGO

Vumbura Camp is situated about 25 kms north of Mombo, in the neighbouring northern private reserve. Vumbura can offer both water and land activities as this area has scenic waterways and is also close to the Okavango's outermost dry savannahs. The water levels around the camp change each year depending on the level of the annual floods from central Africa. Vumbura has both the wetland

and savannah species of wildlife ~ Red Lechwe, Waterbuck, Hippos, Crocodiles, as well as Sable, Kudu, Wildebeest and Tsessebe, who roam the open plains. On game drives we often see more Sable than we do Impala. Herds of Buffalo and Elephant occur here, along with the predators ~ Lion, Leopard, Wild Dog and Cheetah. Guests who enjoy their birding will love the Okavango "specials". Vumbura has eight large tented rooms. We

usually only book up to five rooms, unless a large group is in camp. Each room has hot and cold running water, flush toilet and shower en suite as well as an outside shower. The rooms are tastefully decorated and give Vumbura guests a wonderful feeling of remote Africa ~ while still being comfortable. The main dining, lounge and pub area is tucked beneath a canopy of shady indigenous trees with a superb view across the floodplain. There is a plunge

pool, too. Vumbura offers mokoro excursions, walks, boating and game drives. Night drives are a highlight. The variety of wildlife here is stunning. Guests can go out by boat in the morning and see Hippos, Crocodiles, Red Lechwe and all the aquatic wildlife ~ and then travel out by Land Rover in the afternoon to see Elephant, Sable and all the dry savannah game and predators.
